

## **2019 Summer Internship**

### **2019 Summer Education Internship (*Paid*)**

Work within Sharlot Hall Museum's Education Program in Prescott, Arizona from May 27<sup>th</sup> to August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 (to complete 250 internship hours). Research, design and facilitate summer youth and family programs; and help to carry out children's programs during festivals. Intern will also assist with other museum duties, including supporting museum volunteers, conducting local history research and writing for public audiences. Additionally, the Intern will complete readings and engage in discussions about the museum field and museum education. Start date and completion date of the Internship are flexible. Expected time commitment is 32-40 hours per week at \$11.00/hr. Employee benefits are not available. Housing is not provided.

**Education and Background Desired:** A completed college degree is not required. However, the Intern should have college credits in history, public history, museum studies, education, geography, or a related humanities field. Internship will provide valuable experience for anyone pursuing a career in museums, or an Associate's or Bachelor's degree in history, public history, or education. Preference will be given to those who have completed an undergraduate degree.
